This Deed made this 28th day of June 1874 between John Shadys son of Morris Shadys his wife to the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part and James Dauphin of the County of City of Right and state of Virginia of the second part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him or his heirs paid by the said James Dauphin to the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges they the said Shadys doth and the said James his wife do give, grant, bargain, sell and have all their property known and to be known by the name of James Dauphin in the County of Southampton, the same or either Williamsburg alias Dauphin and bounded at the North by the lands of Lewis Smith as the said land and East by the lands of Judith Lee, bounded and so forth by the lands of Charles G. Davis (Signed) of Education was founded during the year 1870, also in such parties to the first part adverse generally the said above mentioned and divided, dividing being agreed to be sufficient to the same until the 1st day of January 1876.
