

Now all and by these presents that I, Miles Howell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my daughter California S. Ferguson, wife of Doctor E. Ferguson, of the said County and State as well as further consideration of five dollars to me in hand paid by the said California S. Ferguson, I do before the sealing and delivery of these presents, do bind and grant unto the said California S. Ferguson during her life and in case she die before her husband that in that case I leave the land & mutual debt to her husband during her life only with the provision that he will leave the land no case to take or sold for his Doctor E. Ferguson debts and of his the said Ferguson and give the said land to the lawful children of my daughter California S. Ferguson who do my lawful child that in this case give the said land to be equally divided between my four sons so that I may have the living, and certain tract of land containing by superficies one hundred acres of land west of left, with the following boundaries: Beginning at Dellaunee's corner running to road keeping it until coming to J. S. Howell's line, then following Elmer H. Ferguson's line with corner to where my land ends E. to Ferguson's East, corner then returning following top line just as it comes to the land which I gave the children of Revd. Dr. Griffon and others to Dellaunee's Howell's line from where I started. To have and to hold the said land agreeable to the above conditions and in said Miles Howell's name to remain generally the above described land. In witness whereof I have countersigned my hand the 1st day of July 1874.

Schell and James Howell do hereby make the said Bond to Evans (trustee) the following property their corps of coal fields, which had been cultivated this year on this land, including also in part of the land and fields to be made up the land rented and cultivated by Bond to Evans for year & term to receive a debt due by note dated March 1st 1872 for sum of Two thousand and James E.
