of the land toward the Hally Pond road and bounded on the east by the acre and a half now kept  
to fence and to build the said tract or parcels of land with all appurtenances thereto belonging to him  
the said Benj. P. Griffin his heirs or assigns forever. And I hereby warrant and defend the claim of
