Deed for a certain lot of land lying on both sides of the seaboard road between R. D. Bell, town of Franklin, Virginia, and Southampton County, State of Virginia, bounded as follows: Commencing at a piece of land bounded by fifty feet from center of said R. D. Bell road, thence in a northwesterly direction one hundred and four feet to a pine (over red cedar), thence in a duewesterly direction four hundred and twenty feet to another pine tree, thence in a duewesterly direction one hundred and five feet to another pine tree standing (55 ft) fifty feet from center of the opposite R. D. Bell road, thence up the line of said R. D. Bell road four hundred and forty feet to the place of beginning. Also being the same lot of land deeded to G. J. and El. Kelly by Richards Morris and wife dated May 2^d 1867 and recorded in the Deeds Office of Southampton County. To right and left to the said lots of land except a small triangular piece now in Dr. H. M. G. G. which property was given when the said G. M. bought his lot, the Grange, G. J. Kelly, wife and El. Kelly having generally given under one hand each said the 2^d day of July one thousand eight hundred and seventy four.
