general merchandise trading for the County, buying and selling dry goods, meat,
confectionary, hats, boots, shoes, cotton, leather &c.

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The place of said burial is, at Nunsom's Dike, in Southampton County, Va.

The general partner is Joseph V. Bonham residing in Southampton County, Va.
The special partner is Joseph B. Pike also residing in Southampton County, Va.

5. The Special partner has contributed to the common stock of the said firm, the amount of \$1000.00, to wit the sum of One thousand dollars.
