Pope at his place known as the Stephens place in Southampton County and State of Virginia, to make advancements in money and supplies from time to time during the year 1874 which shall not be more than the sum of \$1000.00 and the said Jesse Dickson on his part promises and agrees to and with the said Pope that he the said Joe B. Pope shall be entitled to and shall have a lien on all the crops which may be raised or grown on said land hereafter more particularly described, upon which said advancements shall have been or may be intended to be expended during the year 1874.
