This Deed made the 20th day of February one thousand eight hundred and twenty two dollars in hand paid by the said C. C. Vaughan of the second part to the said David O. Gray Jr. of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said David O. Gray Jr. has long since sold and transferred and by these presents doth assign sell and transfer unto the said C. C. Vaughan his heirs forever one half of his right title and interest in the farm formerly used by the late Wm. Parker deceased living and dying situated in the County of Gloucester State of Virginia containing three hundred and fourty acres and a half more or less and bounded by the lands of J. D. Gray, C. C. Vaughan, Alfred Parker and others to have and to hold the aforesaid half interest in tract or parcels of land and premises together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining hereto unto the said C. C. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever and the said David O. Gray Jr. for himself and his wife doth hereby contract and agree to and with the said C. C. Vaughan his heirs executors administrators and assigns that he will by these presents forever warrant and defend all of his right title and interest in all of the aforesaid half interest in tract or parcels of land in testimony whereof the said Josiah P. Gray Jr. has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and year first above written.

Test, St Edwards C.C.

This instrument made the 21st day of October in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and seventy four between Mr H. Scott of the one part and Mr A. Bell of the other part witnesseth that the said Mr H. Scott for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Mr A. Bell aforesaid, long since sold and conveyed unto the said Mr A. Bell a certain parcel of land containing by estimation eighty five acres or the land more or less lying and situated in the County of Gloucester State of Virginia which he purchased of the said Mr H. Scott for himself his heirs executors and administrators described as follows, Beg. by the land of Prof. E. Hartford on the south containing at a hickory tree on N. S. Bell line and running a distance over the old mill path to a black pond at the head of Wm. B. branch on the east by the land of Mr A. Bell together with all the privilege and appurtenances to the said land in anywise appertaining and belonging to him and to his heirs and assigns to be above granted to the said Mr A. Bell his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And the said Mr H. Scott for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth covenant with the said Mr A. Bell his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises both by own right and all encumbrances that he has good right to sell and convey the same to the said Mr A. Bell as aforesaid; and that he will not his heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Mr A. Bell his heirs and assigns forever against all lawful demands of all persons. In testimony whereof the said Mr H. Scott has hereunto set his hand and seal this the 21st day of September 1871.
