Whereas that we consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars the receipt of which said sum is acknowledged. The said James & John doth grant unto the said William S. Long a certain piece of land formerly owned by the said Peter & John containing twenty three acres more or less bounded by the lands of Geo. & John Lee, Thos. S. Long, Richd. Pope and Geo. Pope on the east and the said A. J. Pope on the west to several pieces of the title to the said land and defend the title for him to the same. Hill and Henry G. his wife, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and Richard Britton, executor as trustee for the purpose herein named of the second part, Whereas that the said John J. Hill and Henry G. his wife, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars the receipt of which said sum is acknowledged, the following property to wit: a tract of land in the said County of Southampton, containing one hundred and sixty one acres or less, and bounded on the north by the lands of A. J. A. Burgess, estate, death by the law of the said Britton and Jefferson Williams, each by the lands of the said Richard Britton and each by the lands of said John Britton, together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same, doth grant & convey the fragment of the sum of one hundred dollars (100^o) to the said John J. Hill, executor, administrator or assignee with right here and interest for annum from the day, date by said deed this day and payable in cash - with power to said Richard Britton to sell and lease as the law directs, and after paying all charges attending said sale, what may be said debt and interest and of a surplus remain, pay the same as the law directs.
