

This Deed made the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1874, between John H. Jordan of Southampton County, Virginia, of the first part; and Wm. Edwards Cole, of County and State of Virginia, of the second part, witnesseth that he said John H. Jordan of County and State aforesaid, and party of the first part, did grant and convey unto the said Wm. P. Strickland, Son-in-Law and heir of the tenth part, his entire Corp of Chattel personal and real, heretofore he now resides, and belonging to said R. Bryant, to secure a debt due to himself Mr. Bryant by acts and true accounts, and amounting to \$1200<sup>00</sup> One hundred dollars, and which being ye party of the first part, has demands at his hand and affords his recd, this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1874.

I, Wm. Edwards Cole and Strickler A, his wife of this date of first part, dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of January 1874, did make and enter into this Deed of Trust between us, between us, John H. Jordan, of County and State of Virginia, and the following property to wit, a tract of land in the County of Southampton, Virginia, containing six hundred and sixty eight acres, more or less, adjoining the lands of the Branch, Collier, Strickler, Patrick, Cole, and the several others, the following shall attest to wit, all his household and kitchen furniture, farm utensils, and horses, cattle, hogs and stock of all kinds, and interest therein, and all sorts of real, personal property, fruit and fixtures, and all other the said kind and sort of money, and all interest therein, have been paid, except the debt made this 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1874, between the said John H. Jordan and Wm. P. Strickler, Strickler et al, consisting of the sum and value of one thousand dollars, and the said Wm. P. Strickler, signed by him being a party thereto, has remitted and released unto the said John H. P. Strickler and to his heirs and assigns forever, the land aforesaid and its appurtenances, and the personal property aforesaid;
