

Witnessed by a Deed of Bond from James D. Estabrook and Nancy S. his wife, to Abigail Smuts, dated April 1st 1874, and recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, Virginia, on the 1st day of May 1874, the said James D. Estabrook and Nancy S. his wife, did convey to the said Abigail Smuts, 200 acres of land situated in Southampton County, Commonly known as Estabrook's Land, bounded by the lands of James and Scott Herring, Jas. W. Edwards & others, tract to secure the payment of said Estabrook according to their promises, and, in consideration of the sale of the said real estate, by the said Smuts, James Estabrook bound the purchasers by bidding for her the sum of three hundred dollars, and has fully paid the sum above named.

Wm Thompson died made this 1st day of October 1874 between Abigail Smuts, as aforesaid, and J. E. Estabrook of the aforesaid Herringfield. Had in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars, the said Abigail Smuts, doth hereby grant and convey with special warranty to the said J. E. Estabrook, to have his heirs forever, the said 200 acres of land more particularly described being in his said

This Deed made the 1st day of December in the year 1874 between N. H. Kerfeld (Trustee) party of the first part and Jas. W. Edwards of the second part and A. R. Edwards party of the third part: Whereas, by deed dated the 21st day of May 1874 and of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, Virginia, I, the said Jas. W. Edwards, did convey to the said N. H. Kerfeld and A. R. Edwards, under the first title of A. R. Edwards, the principal of a certain bond executed by said Jas. W. Edwards and payable to said N. H. Kerfeld & A. R. Edwards, bearing date the 21st day of May 1874, and for the payment of said bond, did then set forth a certain tract or parcels of land situated in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows: East by lands of G. W. Neidman, thence down the south line of his land to a point where said Road meets the south line of the lands of Jas. W. Edwards, thence west along said Road to Cedar swamp, thence down Cedar swamp to a Cypress corner between said Neidman and Edwards and thence the said lands has been fully paid, and the said Jas. W. Edwards doth now land to be released to find. And whereas, this deed it is my intent that the said N. H. Kerfeld in consideration of the premises, and by and with the consent of the said A. R. Edwards & A. R. Edwards takes to be their becoming a party to this deed and signing and sealing the same, doth grant and release unto the said Jas. W. Edwards all such documents, papers or records which are in said County of Southampton and bounded as follows: East by lands of G. W. Neidman, thence down Cedar swamp, thence to a marked Cypress corner of G. W. Neidman and said lands, then along south line and Neidman road to seaboard, thence R. R. fence along road R. Road to Cedar swamp, containing by estimation eighty acres more or less. I do bring the said tract of land enclosed by Joseph Lewis of Memphis Town, to said Jas. W. Edwards and the said A. R.
