

This Deed made this 19th day of December 1874 between Joseph Edwards of the first part and
 G. C. Vaughan Trustee of the second part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia Attorneys
 the said Joseph Edwards of the first part doth grant unto G. C. Vaughan Trustee of the second part one
 acre and one half of land being more or less bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a
 corner of land owned by one John Cunningham &c. above as being twenty four acres and one fourth
 of an acre more or less situate in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and being the
 19th day of January 1876, said land bearing interest at the rate of nine per cent per annum
 until paid for any bond and until the 19th day of December 1878.

This Deed made this 28th day of January and thousand eight hundred and seventy three
 between Nathl. Daugherty and Arden his wife, G. C. Vaughan and Arden his wife, and Jas. G. Cunningham
 and Elizabeth his wife of Southampton County Virginia, of the one part, each for G. C. Vaughan
 Edward Arden Arden, Wm. Carlwood Arden and Cassandra Arden, children of Arden Arden (deceased), of the
 one part, of the other part - This deed makes part of the first part, & in consideration
 of the sum of two hundred and sixty six dollars and fifty cents, grant with general warranty and the
 said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns forever; ten per cent of land in the said
 County of Southampton, being parts of the land formerly owned by Jas. G. Cunningham and purchased
 by the parties of the first part of John W. Albright in Southampton County Virginia - one
 of which parcels contains nine and four-fifths acres, more or less, and is described and bounded as follows -
 Beginning at a highway tree, corner of G. Edwards field, a corner for said James, said Arden and
 said Arden, thence Thomas line S 34^o E 68 1/2 poles to a pine, thence N. 27^o E. 32 3/4 poles to a
 sawtooth near a pine, thence N. 24 1/2^o W. 25 1/2 poles to a rock, thence a cross highway (said Arden
 line), thence up rock, rock S. 27. W. 32 3/4 poles to the first station - The other parcel contains
 five, nine and a half acres, more or less, and is described and bounded as follows - Beginning at a
 highway tree at the mill pond, corner for J. G. Edwards, said Arden and Arden, thence N. 24
 1/2^o W. 37 poles to highway tree and the old mill pond, near a Cypress, thence down said mill
 pond Christopher's mark, to where the park comes to the pond near a Cypress, a high water mark, thence
 S. 65. E. 4 poles to a rock, thence an oak thence the pond and path, thence S. 27^o W. 162 poles to
 the first station, together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same.
 And whereas, the purchase money the said of twenty four dollars has been paid and the sum
 of \$191.50 remains unpaid, and which is to be paid by said parties of the second part in instal-
 ments, to wit: of \$50. on the first day of January 1874, of \$50. on the first day of January 1875,
 of \$50. on the first day of January 1876, and of \$41.50 on the first day of January 1877, all money
 to be paid on the first day of January 1878, and for which we witness evidence with father by the deed
 is entered at all of said sum of \$191.50 is to be paid annually and on just and approved; and
