This 22<sup>nd</sup>, made the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year 1878, between J. G. Blackwell of the City of  
Richmond 25<sup>th</sup> of the first month, Geo. C. Price, T. A. Holt and Daniel T. Smith of the County of Staunton 52<sup>nd</sup>  
of the said month and J. G. Ettinger and Edwards of the City of Franklin 7<sup>th</sup> of the third month, known as  
Geo. G. Price, T. A. Holt and Daniel T. Smith in each name, the said J. G. Ettinger and Edwards the  
sum of the sum of Fifred Hundred and Seven Dollars. (\$1516.25) due by South and Company, bankers  
the fifteenth day of November 1872, now due in the office of the Clerk of Franklin City, and  
in County Court of Staunton County, Oney and son, J. G. Blackwell bears his hand and signature, certain Charles  
W. Davis is the said debt as follows: One twenty five thousand four hundred dollars Ettinger and Edwards Ettinger with  
England 10 thousand \$10000.00 due and unpaid, marked by some scribble that reads like a zero and has three figure zeros  
at each stage. (One fifteen 15) plus two 10000 inches long over all and has thirty four dollar bills two and  
one half inches diameter each bill and one hundred and one dollars with three figures of carriage  
fee and bank notes, sixty feet of twelve inch four ply quill tail and one forty four inch. Dated 1872  
one (one year old) for the rest and bearing of which date outside the said instrument when and where by a freight  
agent. He said Ettinger and Edwards were manufactured by J. G. Ettinger & Edwards of the City  
of Richmond State of Virginia. Being the property conveyed in part of several lands to party of first  
part by said Ettinger and Edwards November 1872, and the sum of money further hundred and Eleven  
\$11.00 being paid fully paid to said J. G. Ettinger and Edwards. The said Geo. G. Price, T. A.  
Holt, and Daniel T. Smith have received the same, confirmed by the said debt of trust to the said  
J. G. Blackwell, in said property, known before mentioned and described, to one acre, and the said G. G.  
Price, T. A. Holt and Daniel T. Smith. Does die, stay, witness, acknowledge and bind the amount of the  
sum of the sum of five dollars, the said J. G. Blackwell agrees to set with the amount of the  
said J. G. Ettinger and Edwards required by their signing and sealing this debt, debt above to the said  
Geo. G. Price, T. A. Holt and Daniel T. Smith all the claim upon the said property.
