as purchased by the said Geo. A. Stephenson, of Wm. L. Stephenson and Wm. C. Stephenson, both
of G. Stephenson deceased, with the will annexed, containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less, the bounds
as his tract by Pennell road, South by Pennell Hill Swamp, East by the lands of P. H. Stephenson
West by road still swamp and the said Pennell road, the said Geo. A. Stephenson, did hereby
individually the right and title to the said tract of land, with general warranty.
