Received by an attorney, returned to Edward Davis C. Morris and Jas. C. Gilliam dated Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> 1874, and recorded in the Clerk's office of Southampton County. The said Davis C. Morris did agree to convey to the said Jas. C. Gilliam, a certain tract of land situated in Southampton County, containing 116.5 acres, between the said Gilliam should pay to the said Morris the sum of five thousand dollars, and whereas the said Gilliam has fully paid all of the purchase money for the said tract of land. The said Gilliam has also made the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1874, between Davis C. Morris of the first part, and Jas. C. Gilliam of the other part, a Deed, that in consideration of the sum of five thousand dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Davis C.
