Long all supplies necessary to carry a farm for the year 1875, not exceeding (1000) One thousand dollars. That the said Wm G. Long shall build himself his reservoir, accommodations &c. to carry to the said Elias P. Vick, one mile, forming islands, bays and all rights where he may now during the year 1875, and this agreement shall constitute a bond on said articles above mentioned, until she aforesaid amount is satisfied.
