Vick further agrees to furnish said Mrs. G. Byrnes with supplies necessary to carry on a farm for the year 1875 next, amounting to one hundred dollars. And the said Mrs. G. Byrnes doth bind herself, his executors, administrators &c. to carry to the said Elias R. Vick, one tract, forming about 400, and all crops which he may raise during the year 1875, and this agreement shall constitute a lien on said article above mentioned, until the aforesaid amount is satisfied.
