Gordons in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars cash paid with general warranty, unto the said Charles H. Miller and his heirs and assigns, forever the following real estate, to wit, a tract or parcel of land in Southampton County aforesaid, containing five hundred acres more or less, and is part of a tract of land of fifteen hundred and fifty six and a half acres, conveyed to said H. T. Gordons, by his father Charles H. Gordons, his wife by deed dated the 21st day of April 1857 and recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County aforesaid on the 21st April 1857 (Eight hundred acres of said tract having been so sold on the 15th January 1872, Conveyed by said H.
