Johnson of said County and State of the second part, Witness: Thomas James Johnson and John C. Johnson his sons at law, and whereas the said George D. Johnson and William C. Johnson being desirous to divide said land by a Grid of Landlines, Survey and Consideration of the premises and also in consideration of a deed executed by the said George D. Johnson conveying to the said William C. Johnson all his right, title and interest in and to certain portions of the High St. Johnson tract of land hereinafter described. The said William C. Johnson and Alice his wife do grant and convey unto the said George D. Johnson all their right, title and interest in and to each portion of the above Johnson tract lying on the Eastern side of the County road and bounded by a line beginning on said road at William H. Sutherlin line thence Eastwardly along said County road to a corner on said line, thence Southwardly along the said Sutherlin line to various corners to a small S. Bondini line thence Northwardly along the said Bondini line to a bridge or a run across for the said George D. & W. C. Johnson, thence Northwardly along a section of Chopped trees to a bridge, a corner tree on said line, thence Northwardly along the said run line of Chopped trees to a Black Run a corner tree on this line thence a little North of North along said line of Chopped trees to a Run, a corner on said line, thence Northwardly along said line to the County road, the point of beginning.
