This Deed made this 8th day of February 1875 between Anne Joyner and Richard A. his wife grantors of the first part and William Joyner (of Blood) grantee of the second part (all of the County of Northampton State of Virginia) Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars paid by the said William Joyner granted aforesaid they the said Anne Joyner and Richard A. his wife do grant with general warranty unto the said William Joyner the following real property to wit, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Northampton and bounded by the lands of R. V. and H. V. (formerly the West-truck) William Brambley, Margaret Bristol Mrs. A. Pitts and David C. Grogg.
