Parkman on the crops which may be made during the year 1875 upon the lands of which the said Whitley cultivate for the above cash of advance which has been or was intended to have been expended, this lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1875 entitled and for to record a document for agricultural purposes. This Deed made this 11th day of February 1875 between William A. Hyricks of one part and John C. Drake of party, Hampshire that whereas the said John C. Drake and his wife & Drake his wife did on the 5th day of March 1874 convey to the said William A. Hyricks two back or parcels of land adjoining each other situated in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded by the State Line the land formerly owned by Philip Conrad the land of Richard Bonds Bonded and Hyricks and William A. Hyricks did to wit: three acres at the Dingemans back containing eighty four acres the other tract containing one hundred and forty six acres formerly owned by Philip Hyricks one being more and her future interest. These with one and three quarters more and one acre more and three quarters and more to wit: the payment of the following bonds and debts due the March the 5th 1875 for one hundred and sixteen dollars sixty nine cents and other due for County taxes and sixty seven cents due the 5th day of March 1875 to William A. Hyricks and whereas the said John C. Drake having fully paid one note for the said debt desires that the said of such amount be released and the property thereby exempt be remoyed
