This Deed made this 15th day of February in the year of 1875 between John C. Drake and Rebecca C. Drake of the one part and Rebecca C. Drake of the other part witnesseth that the said John C. Drake and wife Rebecca C. Drake doth grant unto the said Rebecca C. Drake with general warranty the following property to wit the tract of land and premises on which the said John C. Drake now lives and known as the Carroll Court Doach containing by estimation and hundred and forty four acres to be the same more or less and adjoining the lands of J. C. Davis known as the Myrick Doach the City Doach and other also one hundred and forty six acre parcel of the said Myrick Land adjoining the lands of Thos. A. Myrick, Wm C. Davis known as the South Myrick Farms and others. In Deeds to receive the following debt and to be paid to the said Rebecca C. Drake in a handy amount of Dollars, one hundred and twenty seven dollars and thirty cents and bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from the date of this Deed until the same shall be paid in full. And the said Rebecca C. Drake shall have power to cash at the request of either one of the parties hereto after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale and the proceeds after paying or satisfying the cost and expenses of this Deed shall be applied to the payment of the above named debt and interest due and to the said Rebecca C.
