Deed of Deed made this 1st day of January, And Whereas Eight hundred and twenty five dollars William H. Hobart of the City of Norfolk of the first part and Richard A. Bristol of Guelphord County, of the other part, Whereas - have just consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty (750) Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the aforesaid William H. Hobart do hereby grant unto the aforesaid Richard A. Bristol all of his title and interest to his tract or parcels of land lying in Guelphord County, in Block the first, containing eight acres more or less, bounded as follows: east by road by the store lot of the said R. H. Hobart and estate of Mr. Stevenson, south by Richard Hill's swamp, back by the Smithfield Road, east by the lands of R. H. Stevenson. The second piece contains six acres more or less, and is bounded as follows, on the North by Pease's Road, on the South and East by the roads of Emma Evans and the tract by the Smithfield road, the aforesaid William H. Hobart of the last, do hereby specially warrant the rights and title to the aforesaid tract or parcels of land. Will sign the following signature and seal the day and year above written.

Deed of Deed made this twenty fifth day of Feb One thousand eight hundred and forty five between J. D. Butler and Mary J. D. Butler his wife of the first part and Henry Sandford of the second part, Whereas - Henry J. Butler and Mary J. Butler his wife, owners of the first part, do convey to Henry Sandford part of the second part, to teach all their right title and interest to fifty acres of stock pasture of the Christian land in which the said Sandford now lies and which is bounded on the East by the land of John King Hobart and West by the land of Mrs. Hobart and South by J. D. Butler part of said tract back of which she a tract for the following purpose. He said they do make it to have the power to use any rock or profile from the said land, leaving his life for the benefit of his children and he is to have power to use such rock or profiles in any manner he may think best. At the death of the said Henry Sandford the rights to the said land shall have been vested in Andrew Weston Sandford, James Hobart Sandford, son of Henry Sandford and Martha Jane Sandford, wife of Henry Sandford separately, and they may have the power to sell or do whatever seems to them best with the said land.
