This Order of Courts made the 35th day of July 1875 between Augustus Combs and Mrs Susan B. Combs her wife of the County of Southampton of the first part and Joseph B. Prince trustee of the second part and C. C. Whitfield of the third part after taking into consideration of the said C. C. Whitfield in hand paid and the premises heretofore made, by said Augustus Combs and Mrs Susan B. Combs her wife, a good and true consent and general agreement to J. B. Prince trustee, the following property to wit: A certain tract of land situate in Southampton County containing 265 1/2 acres, be the same more or less, bounded by the lands of C. C. Combs her late husband the Northern Neck and M. P. B. together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, all the Household and Kitchen furniture, of said Augustus Combs and wife and the following personal property to wit: One Horse One kind of Cattle and their increase, Twenty four head of Hogs and their increase, One Cuckooing and farming stonewall, Carts &c. In trust to secure to said Augustus Combs, or demand and carrying interest at the rate of six per cent for money lent, it is agreed by the parties to this deed, that no sale shall take place of the whole of the due for the period of Twelve months from this date, provided that the said Augustus Combs shall pay the interest on said land and six hundred and twenty five dollars of the principal of said lands promptly at the expiration of Twelve months from this date and there after in and every year the said C. C. Whitfield and it is further agreed that in case of a sale, it shall be upon credit and not to the credit of the said Mrs Susan B. Combs, upon such terms as said Whitfield may propose, and the interest on said land shall be entitled to five per cent Commission on gross sale.
