

Ex. 2. *This Deed of Trust made the 27th day of February 1875 between John A. Miles of said parts, & J. D. Wright Trustee of said parts, at 3 P.M. of third parts Wilcoxfield, State of General Assembly of said State. A. D. Wright granted the following estate to him. And naked land or land all of my farm implements, carts and wheels, horses and cattle furniture, with their harness, and all the corn and fodder we have. Do trust to receive the sum next of a sum due to me by said John A. Miles by bond for two hundred dollars given January 1st 1872.*

Ex. 3. *This Deed made this 26th day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty five between J. D. Britton and Mary J. D. Britton his wife of the first parts and Peter L. Clark of the second part Wilcoxfield, that in consideration of eight hundred dollars, the said J. D. Britton and Mary J. D. Britton do grant and sell to said Peter Clark, with general warranty, that part of lot Andrew Clark's tract of land on which he (Peter Clark) now resides and happens to contain one hundred and sixty one acres more or less bounded on the north by the lands belonging to the former tract, on the east by the lands of Collin Mathews, deceased, south by the lands of J. D. Britton and William Davis and west by the lands of the said J. D. Britton and Mary J. D. Britton Cormann. That they have the right to carry the said tract to the granite. That they have due no right to encumber the said lands; that the grants shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all incumbrances, and J. D. Britton and Mary J. D. Britton, parties of the first part, will execute such further instrument of the said lands as may be requisite.*
