

Whereat on the 20th day of January 1874 Mr. J. Cott and Armand his wife by their Deed of Deed dated 1873 and carry into S. C. Hills Trustee for the benefit of Deyor and Prequant as a tract of land in Southampton County 97 acres a portion of the Land known as the "Yellow Seaweed Farm" lying on the right bank of the Tuckahoe River and containing 97 acres and three quarters acre more or less and several other plots which caused the total tract and part of which have been sold to said Mr. Cott has given to the said Deyor and Prequant for the benefit of Deyor and Prequant all the consideration named in the said Deed and also for the said Deyor and Prequant being willing to release all estate that he may have to him against the said Mr. Cott. Therefore this Deed made this 1st day of March 1875 between the said S. C. Hills Trustee of the first party for the benefit of Deyor and Prequant and the said Mr. Cott of the other party witnesseth that the said S. C. Hills Trustee and by the consent of Deyor and Prequant in consideration of the premises and also the further sum of Two Dollars and twenty five cents paid to him with special money he said Deyor and Prequant and who said Mr. Cott and to his heirs and assigns forever. Cott of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the one part and Isaac Compton of the County and State aforesaid, of the other part, witnesseth that he and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Isaac Compton at the time of executing these presents, the receipt whereof is both acknowledged, books accounted, bargained, sold and conveyed unto the said Isaac Compton his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land in the aforesaid County and State lying on the James River side and is a part of the land known as the "Hill's Island" tract adjoining and bounded by the land of J. C. Cott and by the Hill's Island tract bounded on the West by Deyor and Prequant and on the North west by J. C. Cott containing forty five acres, by survey mark or lot to know and to hold the same but informed improvements and appurtenances heretofore belonging to him the said Isaac Compton his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mr. Cott and his heirs and assigns grant the premises herein conveyed to the said Isaac Compton his heirs and assigns as good and lawful title as the aforesaid land and tract are held and have at authority to convey the same and shall the said Isaac Compton his heirs and assigns shall have peaceful possession of the same, free from the claims of Mr. J.
