Hodge, was this day returned and filed for receipt; And at a Court held in the said County on the 18th day of March 1775, the said account having been examined and upwards in the Clerk's Office and no exceptions being filed thereto, it was examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

This Deed made the 10th of March 1775 between C. C. Hodge of the first part, and S. H. Edwards Trustee of the second part, Witnesses that we and for the consideration of the sum of Five (500) hundred dollars Cash paid to me by C. C. Hodge and for other lawful the following property is hereby conveyed to secure the above sum of five hundred dollars. Two Bay Mare, valued at \$40.00 one Saddle and two sets of Harness. One Cow and Wholes and all other of my personal property.

This Deed made the 8th day of January in the year 1775 between R. A. Brister of the first part, Salathiel Swist of the second part and Joel H. Brister of the third part, all of the County of Franklin and State of Virginia, Witnesses:

They entered by a Book of Deeds recorded on the 28th day of July 1772 and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Franklin County the said Book of Deeds and M. S. Brister and his wife did convey unto the said R. A. Brister Trustee, a certain lot of land lying and being situated in the Village of Brimfield and bounded by Spital Night and about, M. S. Brister, to warr to the said Salathiel Swist two several parts of the sum of Seven Hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars each having date on the 28th day of July 1772, and whereas, since the recording of said Book of Deeds the said two several parts having been fully paid the charges and conveyed as indicated by the signatures and Seal of the said S. Brister to these presents, Therefore in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars the said R. A. Brister hath hereby released and conveyed unto the said Joel H. Brister, with special Warranty, the aforesaid lot of land and bounded as the date as follows, And the work by Salathiel Swist, and the deed by S. H. Brister, and the deed by Brister Council, and on the Seal by name of Brister.
