Deed made the 29th day of March 1875 between Benjamin Connell and Edward his wife grantor of the first part and Walter R. Edwards teneant at law of the second part, (all of the County of Gloucester State of Virginia) Testifying that the said Benjamin Connell and Edward his wife grantor of the first part above named do grant with general warranty unto the said Walter R. Edwards trustee aforesaid, the following real property to wch a certain parcel or tract of land lying in the several County of Gloucester and bounded as follows on the South by the land of said Benjamin Connell, said boundary indicated by a line commencing at Street corner of said Benjamin Connell and said corner shared in wth L. C. and E. Joyce and off said line between said Joyce and said Connell, shared in wth L. C. and E. Joyce along a hedge row to a bush gnat near Bush path leading to Franklin, in said town lying to a river the back extending behind said Connell's land and Joseph Gray's on the south east and east by Joseph Gray's lands; on the south and E. by W. Edwards' land, on the west by the land of said Benjamin Connell (by the old trees now before the purchase of said land being removed) and on the N. by the land of Dr. Scott containing by estimation nearly five acres more or less, being a part of the land purchased by said Connell of Dr. J. D. Edwards and sold by him under bankr. sale of Dr. J. D. Edwards, in trust to secure the following debt to wch one note of one hundred and eighty one dollars and date 29th day of March 1875, in favor of Alfred Penru.
