Articles of Agreement made and entered into this first day of April 1875
 betwⁿ H. H. Drury & Co. of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, of the first part, and
 Daniel Chapman of the second part, in pursuance of the 15th section of the
 115th Chapter of the Code of 1873. To wit: That the said H. H. Drury & Co. agree, on their
 part, to furnish to the said Daniel Chapman, sufficient to the amount of fifty
 farming operations for the current year 1875, in the County of Loudoun, Virginia,
 said Daniel Chapman do hereby bind himself, his heirs, administrators and assigns
 to assign to the said H. H. Drury & Co. all their crops of cotton made during
 the year, and do furthermore covenant and agree, that the said crops shall constitute
 a lien on all the crops and any other property then and on each year hereafter
 until the entire indebtedness of said Daniel Chapman shall have been fully paid off and
 discharged. And the party of the second part hereby waives the benefit of their
 Homestead Exemption as to the crops.
