Articles of Agreement, made and entered into this first day of April 1875, between H. H. Conway, Jno. of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, of the first part, and Solomon Doss of the second part, in pursuance of the 12th Section of the 1st & 2^d Chapter of the Act of 1872. The said H. H. Conway Jno. agreed on their part, to furnish to the said Solomon Doss supplies to the amount of not exceeding twenty dollars to enable the said Solomon Doss to carry on their farming operations for the current year, 1875, in the County of Southampton. And in consideration of said advance to be made by the said H. H. Conway Jno. to the said Solomon Doss the hereby binds himself, his heirs, administrators and assigns to deliver to said H. H. Conway and Co. all their crops of cotton made during the year; and in furthermost witness and agree, that the said Doss shall constitute a lien on all the crops and made and about Corn, Barley, Wheat, Hay, and other crops until the said indebtedness of said Solomon Doss shall have been fully paid off and discharged. And the party of the second part hereby waives the benefit of their Homestead Exemption as to this Contract.

This indentured made this first day of September 1870, between Daniel H. Joyner and William A. Joyner and wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia grantors of the first part, and Charles Reed of the County and State aforesaid grantees of the second part, Plaintiff: That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to us in hand paid, by the said party of the second part, as or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, convey, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part, and his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract of land containing one hundred and fifty, more or less Acs. commencing at a
