January 1876 and the said John J. Hullard agrees with the said Priest and Powell
to take of the said land more and five heads of cattle and if to the said Hullard
he should not pay to said Priest and Powell one or before the 1st day of December 1875 the
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with interest from the day of January 1874 to
divide to said Priest and Powell at their store house at Gloucester the said Powell
more and five heads of cattle.
