

Witness by a debt certified by Alberb M<sup>r</sup> Applewhite and Laura R<sup>m</sup> his wife and recorded in the Clerk Office of the County Court of Gloucester County on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1875 the said Applewhite & wife did convey to Mr Edwards with general reservation certain tract or parcels of land situated in the Township of Gloucester in the County of Gloucester and containing by estimation one hundred and twenty eight acres more or less. In trust to secure the payment of a debt due Henry H. Battis of one hundred and fifty dollars. And whereas the said Alberb M<sup>r</sup> Applewhite has fully paid off and discharged the debt due the said Henry H. Battis and all interest accrued to the said the 15<sup>th</sup> March and found of fact to be released and remitted to him. Now therefore this debt made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1875, between the said Mr Edwards and the said Alberb M<sup>r</sup> Applewhite, that the said Edwards in consideration of the premises does with the consent of the said Henry H. Battis, signified by his signing his name hereto release and remit, with special warranty of the said Alberb M<sup>r</sup> Applewhite the above mentioned and described tract or parcel of land.
