

Whereby a deed executed by Alrick M. Edwards and the said Alrick M. Applewhite, Testimony, that the said Edwards in consideration of the premises, do with the consent of the said Henry M. Bates, signify by his signing his name here, release and convey, with special warranty to the said Alrick M. Applewhite the above mentioned and described tract or parcel of land.
