

This Deed made this 23^d day of March 1775 between Tho^s W. Cull a Justice Commissioner appointed by the Circuit Court of Southampton of the first part and Nathaniel W. English of the second part all of the County of Southampton Virginia. Witnesseth that by virtue and authority of a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County rendered on the second day of March 1775 in the Cause of said Cull against Prings administrator and others in said Tho^s W. Cull Commissioner as appraiser of said goods and convey with special warranty into the said Nathaniel W. English the tract of land purchased by him from Nath^l S. Prings on the 18th day of April 1768 for the sum of 385⁰⁰. Containing forty three acres and bounded and described as follows: on the west and east by the land of Nath^l S. Prings as; on the south by the land of Dr. S. Cedar and on the north by the land of the said Nathaniel W. English.

This Deed made this 19th day of April 1775 between R. H. Prings Commissioner of the first part and George H. Raiford of the other part witnesses that the consideration of the sum of Twenty one dollar and twenty five cents (21⁰⁰ 25) have been granted, bargained and sold 12 acres of land in addition to the 105 acres sold him on December 15th 1771 known as the North land.
