

This Deed made this 23^d day of March 1775 between Jas. H. Calk a Justice Commissioner appointed by the Circuit Court of Southampton of the first part and Nathaniel V. English of the second part all of the County of Southampton Virginia. Witnesseth that by virtue and authority of a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County rendered on the second day of March 1775 in the Cause of Jas. H. Calk against Briggs administratrix and others the said Jas. H. Calk Commissioner at aforesaid left grants and conveys the several warrens unto the said Nathaniel V. English the tract of land purchased by him from Bruch S. Briggs on the 18th day of April 1768 for the sum of \$350. & containing forty three acres and bounded and divided as follows: on the north and east by the land of Bruch S. Briggs dec'd; on the south by the land of Jas. S. Coker and on the West by the land of the said Nathaniel V. English.
