 thousand Eight hundred and seventy four by and between Joseph Gedwin Holland  
 and his wife Edith Holland of the County of Goochland State of Virginia, of the age  
 of 40 and James L. Holland of the County of Westmoreland State of Virginie of the age  
 of 57 years and wife Mary Elizabeth Holland and her husband Joseph Gedwin Holland  
 for and in Consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars and forty cents to them in hand  
 paid by the said Samuel D. Hinson the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
 make granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell  
 and convey all their right title and interest in a certain tract of land  
 situated lying and being in the County of Goochland State of Virginia and on the  
 south side of said Hinchliffe Hill Road and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at  
 a large Pine on the edge of the Hinchliffe Road corner for  
 about 8 rods N. 21 E. to the center of the road near some Cow Holes thence S. 15  
 W. 16 rods to a large Poplar in the bend of a Branch hang down the rest of  
 the branch to the end of a second branch to a black Gum hang down the rest of  
 the said second branch to near Edging Whitley's Corners thence a straight line to the  
 first Station beginning South and West from (744) a post and continuing the  
 said James L. Holland Mill Creek being a part of the tract located at the said  
 Post office, to the same more or less to have and to hold all of our right  
 title and interest in the aforesaid land with all works ways water houses trees to any  
 and every thing appertaining unto the said Land and premises unto him the  
 said James L. Holland his heirs or assigns forever. And the said Joseph  
 G. Holland and Edith his wife do for everafter ever hereinafter remain in aforesaid premises  
 and except the said land and premises unto him the said James L.  
 Holland his heirs executors administrators or assigns to be clear and free from the  
 lawful claim or claim of any other person or persons.
