Schell (Director) of the first part and the second part, Whereas: each for and in consideration of and deliver in hand paid by the parties of the first part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part of the second part, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton County Virginia commonly known as the Daniel Powell place, containing three hundred and two (302) acres, to wit: land more or less bounded on the North by the land of D. C. Pope, South by the land of John P. Powell deceased, on the east by the lands of R. M. Pope and John C. Powell deceased and South by the lands of J. P. Schell and eight dollars and seven K. Corbell of Virginia Deed B. 75 and made date dated 25 January. At Witness our hands and seals this 15th day of April 1875.

Powell, all their right title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land including through timber thereon and lying in Southampton County Virginia, containing 101 acres more or less

and bounded as follows South and West by the formerly jointly owned Quarter Tract. It was the property formerly of and now of the said Robert H. Dutton and his wife.
