Miller is about to engage in the Cultivation of the soil and is desirous to have during the year 1775 advanced in money or supplies from the said Jas. H. Prince for the amount of two Hundred and Twenty five dollars, legend which amount the said Jas. H. Miller shall pay up and to said Jas. H. Prince having agreed on his part to execute such advance at his and the said Jas. H. Miller on his part in consideration of the above premise, does hereby grant a lease to the said Jas. H. Prince upon the terms which may be made during the year 1775 upon the land in the cultivation of which the above amount of advance has been or is intended to have expended. This lease is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, Approved April 25th 1773 intitled and set to secure advance for agricultural purpose. Prince upon the terms which he may make during the year 1775 upon the lands in the cultivation of which the above amount of advance has been or is intended to have been expended. This lease is granted under an act of General Assembly of Virginia, Approved April 25th 1773 intitled an act to secure advance for agricultural purpose.
