Article of Agreement made and entered into this 1st day of May 1875, between Wm. R. Griffin, J. P. of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, of the first part, and George D. Dumas, of Rockingham Co. Va. of the second part, in pursuance of the 12th section of Chapter 116 of the Code of 1873. Viz: That said Wm. R. Griffin, J. P. agreed on 4th inst. to furnish to the said George D. Dumas supplies to the amount of not exceeding seventy five dollars to enable the said Geo. D. Dumas to carry on his farming operations for the current year 1875, in the County of Rockingham. In consideration of sums advanced to be made by the said Wm. R. Griffin, J. P. to the said George D. Dumas to hereby bind himself, his heirs, administrators and assigns, to causing to be paid to the said Wm. R. Griffin, J. P. all his debts of other made during the year, and to discharge all and what the said Geo. D. Dumas shall constitute a lien on all the crops, and mule, one Colt, light head of Hogs, Horse held and other furniture until the entire indebtedness of said Geo. D. Dumas shall have been fully paid off and discharged. And the party of the second part hereby waives the benefit of his Homestead Exemption as to the contents.
