His instrument witnesseth as follows: That inasmuch as I own a God Mount now situated
in a tract of land belonging to me and commonly known as the "Great Glaze" and

survived daughter of mine, I should have the use of said house, then described & hereby agreed
and covenanted that the said Jas. H. George and Jas. G. Applewhite shall for the period of
twelve years from the date hereof the use of the said house, upon the following
conditions and good behavior. Viz. Each one of the said parties is to pay one half of the
expenses for the repairs and maintaining the said house, and in paying either person,
it is to have the use of the said house for one week, and then the other is to have it
for one week, or should the parties make other arrangements about the use of the
said house, such arrangement and by themselves, for and during the said period. I have
no stipulation thereto.

This Agreement entered into this 17th day of May 1875 between H. P. Pope of one part
and Roger Edwards of other part, testifies as follows. That whereas the said Roger
Edwards is about to or has engaged in the cultivation of his land, and is desirous to others
during the year 1875 advanced or supplied fertilizer &c from the said H. P. Pope for
the sum of one hundred and twenty five thousand dollars, dollars legend which amount
the said Roger Edwards shall not go, and he said H. P. Pope having agreed with him
part, to furnish said advanced. And the said Roger Edwards and his party in Consideration
of the above promised, doth hereby grant a lease to the said H. P. Pope on the
land which may be made during the year 1875, upon the land in the cultivation of
which said advanced or advanced has been or was intended to have been expended.
This sum is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Va. approved Feb. 25.
1873, entitled an act to secure a descent for agricultural purposes. Witness the
