

This Agreement entered into this 15th day May 1875 between H. P. Pope and J. S. Barkham of the first part and James H. Joyner of the other part, Witnessed, as follows, that James H. Joyner is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1875 from the said Pope and Barkham for the sum of Fifty dollars, cash, from H. P. Pope Forty Eight and from J. S. Barkham Twenty two dollars twenty which said the said Joyner shall pay to each of the said Pope and Barkham having agreed on their part to furnish said supplies. Now the said J. H. Joyner of his part and in consideration of the above premises did hereby grant a Voucher to the said Pope and Barkham which the copies which may be made during the year 1875 upon the bonds of which the said Joyner shall be liable for the above sum of additional which had been or was intended to have been expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties to this Agreement that the said H. P. Pope shall be paid cash and later paid, after which the said J. S. Barkham shall be paid. This Voucher is granted under and with the Great Seal of Virginia Approved June 25th 1875 attested an oath to leave a demand for a great seal for purpose. Attest the following signatures and seals.
