

Third Agreement entered into this 15th day May 1775 between Mr. S. Peleg and
J. S. Barnard of the first part and James H. Joyce of the other part, Pittsfield, as
follows, each having his said West Joyce's to engage in the cultivation of his in-
tended & destined to obtain sufficient during the year 1775 from the said Peleg and
Barnard for the wants of Edgy delivery, which is to stand 10 P.M. Party Eighty eight each
from J. S. Barnard Party ten dollars hundred weight with Peleg and Joyce shall pay &
and the said Peleg and Barnard having agreed and their friends to furnish such supplies
as the said Peleg and Joyce or his family and his Consideration of the above mentioned
but timely growth of Seven to the said Peleg and Barnard over all the time which may
be made during the year 1775 upon his demand of which the said Joyce will cultivate
in the said land of Pittsfield which has been or was intended to have been re-
ferred to it, Furthermore agreed by the parties to this Agreement that the said Mr. Peleg
shall be first paid and satisfied after which the said J. S. Barnard shall be paid
that said J. S. Barnard under and by the General Assembly of Virginia, November
April 25, 1773 intituled an act to reward aదద for agricultural purposes.
