and fifty dollars (\$150.00) legend which among the said Gray shall not go
and whereas we said Gray and Ferguson having agreed on this point to furnish
said advances, we said G. S. Gray on his part, and in consideration
of the above promised, do hereby grant a Rent to the said Gray and Ferguson
on the lands which are made during the year 1875 upon the sum of \$150.
The above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been spent
this sum is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia April
2^d 1873, entitled and act to secure advances for agricultural purposes
