The Deed of Benjamin and wife from William H Drake and wife to Amwell Amwell and Elizabeth Amwell, and the day records and together with the certificate thereto annexed, admitted to record.

Whereas by a Deed of Trust executed by A. Cromwell and wife on the 14th day of January 1774, conveying to G. C. Vaughan trustee, a certain lot of land lying in the Village of Brambleton, Transylvania County, the land on which the said Cromwell had resided, for some part of the said Deed contained, the said G. C. Vaughan in accordance with the provisions of said Deed, did, after due publication of time and place of sale, on the 15th day of March 1775, sell as follows, to the highest bidder the aforesaid lot of land, in two separate lots, each known as such, the bid of Hilary Catchins was received at the highest made for the first portion of the said Cromwell lot, designated herein as lot No. 1. Wherefore I the said Hilary Catchins for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to the said G. C. Vaughan (Trustee) parts of the first part herein stated, sell and convey with special warranty unto the said Hilary Catchins, parts of the second part, the following portion of the said Cromwell lot, to wit: Commencing on the South side of Ditch Run at the Northeast Corner of Dr. H. Hollands lot, thence easterly to a point on said Run 37 1/2 feet from Hollands Corner as aforesaid, thence Southerly along a line parallel with Dr. H. Hollands and Dr. H. Catchins lot to a point on said Run 105 feet to Dril Runway, thence South 52 1/2 feet East of the said Dr. H. Catchins lot, thence Westerly 52 1/2 feet to a point on the said Dr. H. Catchins line 105 feet South of Dril Runway, thence Southerly along the line of the said Catchins and Hollands lot 105 feet to Dril Runway, the line of beginning continuing by observation and eighth of an acre of land. This Deed made this 8th day of July 1775 between William A. Scott parts of the first part and G. H. Howell trustee of the second part, Whereas the said Dr. H. Catchins of Brambleton, Transylvania Co. Va. has agreed to purchase the said W. A. Scott goods from the said Catchins there to the amount of fifty dollars for the purpose of settling the said Debt to Catchins his crops, therefore he the said Scott doth grant unto the said Howell (Clerk of the aforesaid County of Transylvania and State of Va.) his entire crop of Cotton Beans, Corn and fodder which he the said Scott shall cuttake during the present year, said Crops to be delivered at Brambleton by the 15th day of November 1775, and to be to receive the following dls. And note of fifty dollars due Dr. H. Catchins and dated July 8th 1775, said note being given in consideration of the obligation
