This Agreement entered into this 15th day of March 1875, between J. S. Barham of the first part and W. B. Boyard of the other part, stipulated as follows, that whereas the said W. B. Boyard is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous of obtaining supplies during the year 1875 from the said J. S. Barham for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to wit: wheat, corn, and other provisions, and the said J. S. Barham having agreed on his part to furnish said supplies, in the said W. B. Boyard on his part and in consideration of the above premises that every grant or lien to the said J. S. Barham on the crops which may be made during the year 1875 upon the crops of which the said Boyard cultivated for the work of the above named wheat had been or was intended to have been repaid. This debt is granted upon and of the General Assembly of Virginia, Approved April 2nd 1875 entered on the 15th day of March 1875 for agricultural purposes.
