Archam for the said one hundred and fifty dollars beyond which he shall not go, and the said J. S. Archam having agreed on his part to furnish said supplies, in the said R. L. Boyard on his part and in consideration of the above premises that hereby gave a line to the said J. S. Archam on the crops which may be made during the year 1875 upon the basis of which the said Boyard anticipates for the work of the above named land that has been or will be made to have been expended. This line is granted upon and of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2^d 1873, and is intended to be a security for agricultural purposes.
