Coll of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, and Anthony Wendell of said County and State of the second part, sheweth that for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and fifty dollars to them justly and lawfully due and owing, a writing acknowledged they the said parties of the first part, do grant, bargain, sell and convey with General warranty unto the said Anthony Wendell, party of the second part, Right Certain lot of lands lying in the land of Dranklin, and within High Road of Northham, they and bounded by a line beginning at the intersection of Shick's Run and Northham's Street thence Norwesterly along Northham's Street about 310 feet to Francis Armes, thence Norwesterly along Francis Armes about 50 feet to Mrs Sarah Cornwell's lot thence Norwesterly along the line of Mrs Sarah Cornwell's lot about 310 feet to Shick's Run, thence Easterly along Shick's Run about 50 feet to Northham's Street, the point of beginning, containing by estimate a little less than one acre of land according to the Map of Dranklin, to have and hold the said lot of land to him the said Anthony Wendell his heirs and assigns forever.
