Dollars, in hands paid to him John Broder Alexander G. Broder by the said
Thomas J. Broder the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. He also
says Alexander G. Broder still owns, till and coming with the
said Thomas J. Broder or the following tract or parcels of land containing
by estimation sixty six acres more or less, being the lands formerly owned
by Josiah Rogers (of Lusk) which lands was conveyed to him by Mr.
Edwards (Wester) and recorded in the Clerk's Office of Franklin
County Court the 27th day of April 1871. The said lands is conveyed
with general warranty.
