Steele for the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) bearing date 16th day of August 1875. Noting my hand and seal this 16th day of August 1875.

Story has countersigned the foregoings of this Bond for the sum of stated sum of dollars, bearing date at the 15th day of May 1875 and also to receive a just Consideration the payment of said Bond to which I. S. Story, shall be free and at a distance here written for the sum of One Hundred dollars bearing date on the 15th day of March 1876 and payable on demand the 1stst day of December 1876.
