This Agreement entered into this 20th day August 1875 between Sam Pickard of the first party and Dr. P. Morrison of the other, witnesseth as follows that whereas the said Morrison engaged in the cultivation of his land and is desirous to obtain supplies from the said Dr. Wm. Pickard for the sum of Fifteen Dollars, beyond which sum the said Morrison shall not go, and the said Dr. Wm. Pickard having agreed to furnish said supplies. Now the said Morrison and his party and - consideration of the above aforesaid do hereby grant a lease to the said Pickard and all the crops which may be made during the year 1875 on the lands of which the said Morrison cultivates for the above sum of aforesaid which has been or will intended to have been expended.

Morrison's grantee under and by the General Assembly of Vt. Approved April 23rd 1873 submitted and set to record confirmed for Agricultural purposes.
