Drake for the sum of Forty five dollars at his death to appear at the next term of the County Court to stand his trial for charges now pending.

Now the said Harriman and his party and - Consideration of the above advanced do hereby grant a Lien to the said Dickson on all the crops which may be made during the year 1775 on the lands of which the said Harriman Cultivates for the above sum of advanced which has been or was intended to have been expended, and which is granted under and act of the General Assembly of N. H. approved April 22^d 1775 entitled an act to more advanced for Agricultural purposes.
